Footnotes

LANSING BLUE sped clear of his foes along the inside to the first turn, dictated pace on a clear margin racing just off the inside to upper stretch and held sway to the end under pressure. SMARTY MOUTH tracked just off the pacesetter along the inside as part of the second flight, angled off the inside in upper stretch to challenge but was always second best. PULLMANITE tracked the pacesetter outside a rival in second flight, made a brief bid on the far turn but weakened nearing upper stretch. KOKOMO GYPSY, bumped by FIRE CLOUD at the start, was settled along the inside in the opening stages, made steady progress inside foes leaving the far turn, shifted out in upper stretch and continued to improve position. BUD SYMONDS was steadied a bit in close quarters just after the start, tracked the pace unhurried, then came around tiring foes in the latter stages. IRON CHAMP, caught four wide between foes racing to the first turn, shifted inside nearing the backstretch, made some progress in that path racing to the far turn but came up empty in the drive. MIAMI ICE, buffeted about in tight quarters at the start, never menaced thereafter. FIRE CLOUD broke out, bumped KOKOMO GYPSY, was righted to stalk just off the second flight racing to the far turn and dropped out nearing upper stretch. SPARE ME TEN, caught five wide racing into the first turn, soon retreated from contention.
