HILDA'S PASSION was urged to the fore along the inside, dueled for command into the bend, forged clear entering upper stretch and maintained her advantage under steady pressure. JOCATA tracked the pace between foes in the second flight, found her best stride in upper stretch to split rivals in late stages and prevailed for the place. BEAUTIFUL BLISS, bumped by MISS TWENTY ONE at the start, was quickly righted to stalk just off the pacesetter three wide, contested the issue to upper stretch and weakened late. BENT MISSILE forced the pace outside a rival from the outset, dueled between foes on the bend into upper stretch and gave way. NEVEERRGUWITHRICHIE tracked the pace between foes in second flight racing into the bend but couldn't produce the needed closing bid. BEYONDALLBOUNDARYS was settled outside foes in the opening stages, raced four deep to upper stretch and proved no threat. PRINCESS FREEBIE tracked the leaders in second flight along the inside but came up empty nearing midstretch. MISS TWENTY ONE broke in, bumped BEAUTIFUL BLISS and soon trailed.
