EL VEDA set the pace and opened up, shortened stride then held on late. BLOOD DIAMONDS was well rated and split horses, rallied late and was getting to the winner. PRINCESS MOODY had a slight steady early, angled out and rallied in the stretch while five wide. LE BEE chased the pace while inside, made a bid on the rail but faded. BARONESS DEL SOL stalked the pace, contended to the stretch and tired. PASHA was allowed to settle, angled out but made no rally. GENA DAY rated in the second flight inside, lost action on the turn and tired.
