SOUL COAXING was allowed to settle, ranged up while five wide, was all out and held on. JILLY FROM PHILLY showed no speed, angled out and closed with a rush but just missed. PATH OF HONOR was tucked in early, split horses coming off the turn and was gaining late. S S VICTORY was rushed to the lead and set the pace, led to the stretch and gave way. BAROQUE raced in the second flight, rallied while four wide, was shut off and steadied in the stretch then faded. JUNGLE HEART settled along the inside, was asked but made no rally. MEADOW WISE was rushed up, chased the pace and tired in the stretch.
