### Footnotes

BRILLIANT FUTURE, within striking distance from the outset attending a rival's pace, steadily moved to terms with the pacesetter on the bend, pressed the issue into upper stretch and was roused clear in the last furlong. MY TARA BELLA moved to the fore along the inside soon after the break, dictated the pace on a narrow margin racing into the bend, couldn't match terms with the winner racing through the stretch but proved best of the others. EMONA stumbled at the start, was settled off the second flight in the opening half, made some progress to gain position racing three deep on the turn to upper stretch but couldn't menace the top pair. OH MY SWEETIE PIE tracked just off the first flight along the inside racing to the bend but came up empty nearing upper stretch. NIKALUK gained a position outside a rival tracking just off the first flight racing to the bend, made a brief bid nearing upper stretch but emptied out in the drive. ZAHRAH was settled off the second flight in the opening stages and never mounted a serious challenge.
