Footnotes

MISS KITTEN, reserved in hand off the second flight four wide racing through the backstretch, steadily moved to striking position splitting foes in that path racing through the turn, came through with a sharp move entering upper stretch to wrest command, was driven well clear then was taken in hand in the final stages once the issue was decided. CHELAN ECHO broke readily, took up a position just off the first flight racing through the backstretch, pressed the issue between foes racing through the turn to upper stretch, couldn't match the winner but continued with interest to preserve the place honors. ABBY'S SLEW tracked off the second flight in the opening stages while making her way to the inside, came through close quarters saving ground to upper stretch, then split foes along the inside in the final stages while making an effort to improve her position and prevailing for a share. STELLA GREY tracked the leaders four deep in the second flight from just out of striking distance, made some progress three deep between foes on the turn, then continued between foes in that path racing through the stretch while lacking the needed final kick. GOTTA DANCE settled off the second flight while racing well off the inside in the opening stages, continued five deep into the turn while making some progress to gain contention after five and a half furlongs, was fanned widest into the stretch and flattened out in the drive. DECISIVE ACTION was a brief factor pressing the pace along the inside in the opening half but steadily retreated from the lead on the turn. BELL Z GIRL settled between foes in the second flight racing into the bend, drew into contention while racing in close quarters midway through the turn but offered no closing bid. SO LONG JULIE reared at the start, was urged to gain a position between foes in the second flight racing through the

backstretch but emptied out nearing upper stretch. SECRET INFORMATION was urged to dispute the pace between foes from the break, pressed the issue to gain a narrow advantage along the rail entering the turn, set the pace through the third quarter and gave way once headed by the winner.
