MISS WHATAVU raced close up along the inside, was steadied in the turn then split horses and got up in time. LITTLE BIT A JAZZ pressed the pace, rallied in the stretch but was outfinished. SWEET DARLENE was rushed and set the pace along the inside then gave way late. PEPPERCART dropped back early, moved while five wide and lugged out in the stretch. LOVE AND LIES raced inside and was taken up hard repeatedly for the first half mile then was empty in the stretch. SAVY'S DELITE raced in the second flight, steadied in the stretch and made a mild rally. FASHIONABLE NATURE rated well between horses, lacked room in the turn and had no response when asked. LADY DI CONTE was shuffled back at the start and was no factor. CHRISTMAS PACKAGE was fractious in the paddock, got loose in the post parade and ran off a quarter of a mile, was reloaded in the gate, showed brief foot and tired. ANOTHER GO got off slowly and was no threat. OUR ITTIBITTI was void of early speed and was outrun.
