COPPER FOREST broke out, bumped TIGER STRIKE, was righted to join a rival on the pace while in hand racing just off the inside, edged away to a clear advantage on the bend and widened his margin to the end under pressure. COOL CLUE tracked the pacesetter unhurried along the inside in early stages, saved ground on the bend while making steady progress, couldn't match terms with the winner but held well for the place. TIGER STRIKE, bumped by the winner at the start, was settled along the inside in early stages, saved some ground on the bend, shifted out to split foes in upper stretch and continued willingly for a share. TOCCET ROCKET, held up just out of striking distance while working his way to the inside in early stages, made some progress to improve his position while continuing evenly into the stretch. UMBANI tracked the leaders unhurried outside foes in the opening quarter, was caught four wide racing through the and flattened out in upper stretch. MY EX joined the pace outside the winner from the break, couldn't match that foe after a half and steadily faded nearing upper stretch. LEADING INDICATOR ducked inwards at the start, made some brief progress three wide in second flight racing to the turn but emptied out nearing upper stretch.
