KING A. J., reserved just out of striking distance racing a bit off the inside in the opening stages, gathered momentum leaving the quarter mile marker, shifted out in upper stretch to split foes three wide to challenge the pacesetter in tandem with WILL'S HONEY nearing midstretch and proved best in the closing stages under firm handling. The latter tracked just off the pacesetter along the inside racing to the bend, came through inside the leader to challenge approaching the furlong marker, struck the front but in midstretch but was outfinished. CONNECTIONS broke sharply, dictated the pace off the inside racing to the turn on a clear margin but yielded to the top pair leaving the furlong marker. TAZZ stalked just outside the pacesetter racing into the turn, was carried out a bit by the winner in upper stretch and weakened in the drive. CELLULOID HERO stumbled badly at the start, was settled along the inside racing through the backstretch and offered no rally.
