ZIPPING AWAY broke readily to secure the lead between calls in the opening quarter, continued under firm rating to stalk the pacesetter racing to the turn, moved to command midway through the bend while continuing in hand, then made the balance of the pace while extending her advantage under steady right handed pressure. TWIN POWER, reserved between foes off the second flight early, angled inwards a bit on the turn while moving to contention, shifted out to split foes entering upper stretch, couldn't gain terms with the winner but prevailed for second. LOOKINATMINDY, reserved outside foes off the second flight in the opening stages, made her way nearer the inside after a half, shifted outside foes nearing upper stretch, was fanned five wide racing into the lane and displayed some mild interest to gain a share. EASTERN PRECIPICE, forwardly placed along the inside in the opening stages, shifted out three deep racing through the backstretch, moved to briefly challenge in that path on the turn but gave way nearing midstretch. MYA FACCIA BELLA, held up off the inside in the opening half, made a brief bid four deep after six furlongs but flattened out in upper stretch. SUNDAY TEA BREAK tracked the leaders along inside in the opening stages, saved ground to upper stretch, continued inside foes to late stages but made no impression. LA COLORADA was urged to the fore outside the eventual winner in the opening quarter, angled to the rail to briefly dictate the pace on a narrow margin racing into the turn but emptied out once headed by the winner.
