Footnotes

MR. MISCHIEF angled inwards gaining a position outside a rival in the second flight racing to the backstretch, steadily moved to striking distance while shifting out three deep leaving the far turn and responded to firm left handed pressure to edge STANLEY G. nearing the wire. The latter angled to the rail racing into the first turn while securing a position in the second flight, came through along the inside nearing upper stretch to lodge his bid, contested the issue to the end but came up second best. FOR YOU REppo, held up outside a rival from well out of striking distance early, made steady progress near the inside racing into upper stretch, angled out five wide late and closed the gap on the top pair while earning a share. TIGHT GRIP was urged to the lead along the inside racing to the backstretch, dueled for command into the far turn, edged clear of a rival to gain a narrow advantage in upper stretch but yielded to the top pair in the last furlong. STRIKING HIGHT settled off the second flight racing to the backstretch, angled inwards entering the far turn while making some progress, shifted out in upper stretch and continued evenly between foes. NINTH CLIENT, reserved well off the second flight along the inside in the opening half, swung out nearing upper stretch to race five wide in the stretch but lacked the needed final response. NIC THE QUICK reserved along inside in the opening half, never gained contention. DOCTOR CAL tracked well off the second flight outside a rival in the opening half but offered no closing bid. CALZONE settled off the second flight between foes racing to the backstretch but soon dropped out of contention. KERA'S KITTEN angled inwards while

being urged to join the pace, forced the pace outside a rival racing into the far turn and gave way entering upper stretch. DURAZNO, reserved in hand in early stages, never mounted a serious challenge.
