Footnotes

SANDYS DIAMOND, bumped at the start, was reserved off the second flight racing outside a rival in the opening half, briefly awaited an opening midway through the turn, angled to the rail while quickly threading her way through traffic leaving the quarter mile marker, shifted out three deep to challenge for command, quickly took over and drew away under firm right handed prompting. TINGALEO led the second flight tracking the pacesetter along the inside, saved ground to upper stretch, shifted out sharply near the three sixteenth marker to challenge in tandem with the winner, couldn't match that foe but prevailed for place honors. ADMIRAL ROCKET tracked off the second flight outside foes, was caught four wide on the turn while being urged to gain striking distance and continued willingly in that path racing through the stretch to gain a share. SCRIVENER'S ERROR went clear in the opening quarter while shifting to the inside, dictated the pace on a clear margin into upper stretch but faltered in late stages. GRASS BLADE, bumped at the start, was settled off the field, angled out five wide racing into the stretch to improve position but offered no rally. GOLDEN RULER tracked off the second flight along the inside, shifted out after six furlongs to race between foes in upper stretch but lacked the needed late bid. GOOD CHEMISTRY broke outwards bumping the eventual winner, was righted to track the pacesetter between foes in the second flight racing into the bend but steadily faded nearing upper stretch. TWO PERFECT broke outwards bumping GRASS BLADE, was righted to track the pacesetter three wide as part of the second flight racing to the turn but gave way nearing upper stretch.
