### Footnotes

GOLD FORMER was settled off the second flight racing to the backstretch, steadily moved to contention three and four deep between foes racing into the far turn, shifted outside foes to challenge five deep leaving the furlong marker and prevailed in time under steady handling. LIGHTHOUSE PRIDE, shuffled back in traffic at the start, shifted near the inside on the backstretch while splitting foes, continued with a steady effort to challenge three deep leaving the far turn, drifted inwards nearing the furlong marker bumping SAILING ALONG but finished with interest to prevail for place honors. KING ROOTIN TOOTIN, reserved four deep off the second flight in the opening stages, angled inwards nearing the far turn while gathering momentum, was steadied slightly entering upper stretch, was fanned six wide nearing the furlong marker but continued with a steady late response to close the gap and gain a share. FIRE CLOUD broke outwards bumping GRATTAN STREET, was collected to track off the second flight along the inside, shifted out in upper stretch and continued with interest between foes to improve his placing. SAILING ALONG, urged to secure a forward placing, tracked off the pacesetter between foes on the backstretch, made a steady effort to challenge nearing upper stretch, drew on terms with the pacesetter midstretch, was steadied sharply when bumped from both sides, then squeezed back leaving the furlong marker and lost his momentum. MASTMAN was urged to secure terms with a rival on the pace, inherited the lead before a half, dictated the pace on a clear margin to upper stretch, drifted out nearing the furlong marker bumping SAILING ALONG and quickly gave out. DEVILS TOWER, restless in the gate prior to the start, was reserved well back to the far turn, then passed some tiring rivals. SACRED

GIFT angled to the inside while gaining a position in second flight racing to the backstretch, was pulling hard after the opening quarter while being guided a bit off the inside, made a brief bid racing through the far turn but emptied out in upper stretch. LUMBERYARD JACK tracked the pace three deep off the second flight, was carried out by GRATTAN STREET nearing the backstretch and never gained contention. DOUBLE JACK, fractious in the gate before the start, flashed brief pace along the inside racing to the backstretch but gave way abruptly before a half. GRATTAN STREET, bumped at the start, was a bit rank between foes, shifted out nearing the backstretch, lodged a brief, four wide bid midway through the backstretch but stopped abruptly entering the far turn. FOLLOWING THE RACE THE TRAINER OF SAILING ALONG LODGED A CLAIM OF FOUL AGAINST LIGHTHOUSE PRIDE. THE STEWARDS CONDUCTED AN INQUIRY INTO THE STRETCH RUN AND DETERMINED ACTION WAS NOT WARRANTED.
