Footnotes

MR NUM NUM, reserved off the second flight while making his way to the inside in the opening stages, commenced a steady advance along the rail entering the bend, came through inside the pacesetter to challenge leaving the furlong marker and just drew on even terms with that foe at the wire under firm right handed encouragement. ITALIAN BREEZE was urged to a forward placing along the inside in the opening stages, edged away to a clear advantage racing through the turn, held sway past the furlong marker and just lasted to finish on even terms with a rival at the wire. RYAN'S REX, off a step slowly, was urged to a contending position along the rail nearing the turn, chased the pacesetter into upper stretch but had no final kick. IOLANDA'S PERFECT, reserved off the inside behind the second flight in the opening stages, angled inside on the turn while making some progress, shifted out four wide in upper stretch but lacked the needed final kick. EIGHT GAUGE tracked off the second flight three deep between foes early, was urged to advance while caught four, then five wide racing through the turn and steadily faded racing into upper stretch. WILDWOOD PERFECT tracked the pace outside foes in the second flight racing to the turn but offered no closing response. SAY SONNY was rated between foes in the second flight in the opening half, split foes making a brief advance on the turn but emptied out nearing upper stretch. CAPTAIN AMERICAN was settled off the second flight four deep in the opening stages, angled to the rail nearing upper stretch but proved no real threat. LEAL RIDGE was outpaced along the inside and never seriously menaced. HE'S SMASHED pulled way to fore outside foes in the opening stages, shifted in briefly disputing the lead and emptied out after a half.
