GENTLEMANS CODE ducked out at the start crossing the path of RARE COURAGE and making some contact with TRUEBILL, was righted while gaining terms with a rival on the pace along the inside, pressed the issue on the turn, shook clear racing into upper stretch and held sway to the end under firm encouragement. HEIR TO DIXIE tracked just off the first flight under light rating in the opening stages, loomed three wide nearing upper stretch but lacked the needed final response while prevailing for place honors. TRUEBILL, bumped at the start, angled to the inside tracking just off the leaders racing into the bend, saved ground to upper stretch and finished evenly in late stages. ADENA'S CHANCE tracked the leaders three deep outside foes from out of striking distance in the opening stages was urged to gain some position while shifting to the five path entering upper stretch but finished evenly in late stages. LOVE REIGNS settled between foes while making his way nearer to the inside in the opening stages, shifted out four wide entering upper stretch while being prompted but offered no rally. RARE COURAGE, shut off at the start, settled along the inside and never gained contention. ROCKISLAND EXPRESS secured terms with a rival attending that foe's pace in the opening stages but emptied out nearing upper stretch.
