MOP HEAD was rated just out of striking position along the inside tracking the first flight racing to the turn, shifted out three wide while steadily advancing on the leaders entering upper stretch and produced a steady late bid to wrest command and kick clear in time under some right handed prompting. COSTILLA RANGE angled to the inside dictating the pace on a narrow margin racing through the backstretch, duelled for command inside a rival into upper stretch, gained a narrow advantage nearing the furlong marker but proved no match when confronted by the winner. J J GARBAR was firmly rated just off the first flight outside a rival racing to the turn, was urged to advance while shifting to the four path entering upper stretch and made some mild progress in that path while prevailing for a share. TENSAW, off last, was settled outside foes in the last flight racing to the turn, swung five wide racing into upper stretch but made no real impression on the leaders. CALL TO GLORY joined the pace between foes in the opening stages, pressed the issue outside a rival racing through the turn and emptied out nearing midstretch. SCORE BABY SCORE settled off the second flight along the inside in the opening stages and never gained striking distance. TRADEWATER, within striking distance four deep in the opening stages, moved to briefly press the leaders three deep nearing the turn but gave way abruptly entering the turn.
