PIRATES VOW broke sharply, angled to the inside dictating the pace on a clear margin racing into the turn, set the pace into upper stretch and was roused racing through the lane to maintain a clear advantage. J. PA tracked off the second flight along the inside, saved ground steadily gaining position inside foes on the turn but couldn't gain terms with the winner. MR. FLEXIBLE settled along the inside in the opening stages, saved ground on the turn, swung five wide entering upper stretch and made some mild progress in that path to prevail for a share. PETERS ROCK tracked the pacesetter between foes in the second flight racing into the turn, was bumped by SORROWFUL JONES entering the turn, continued with a steady effort to bid between foes nearing upper stretch but faded leaving the furlong marker. UNO PECADOR tracked the pacesetter four wide in second flight in the opening stages, chased that foe three deep on the turn and steadily faded in the drive. NO GOOD DEED was settled outside foes in the opening stages, came under pressure while switching out six wide in upper stretch but offered no rally. SORROWFUL JONES, close up three deep between foes in the second flight in the opening stages, shifted inwards nearing the bend bumping PETERS ROCK and gave way nearing upper stretch. UPSELL tracked the pace outside a rival off the second flight in the opening stages but retreated from contention early.
