Footnotes

TOP PAIR was urged to secure a contending position along the inside in the opening stages, moved to striking distance along the rail midway through the bend, briefly awaited an opening leaving the turn, switched out sharply approaching midstretch to challenge outside the leaders, wrested command late and went clear under firm encouragement. PRINCES EVEN was settled in hand along the inside, made steady progress inside foes entering the turn, shifted out four wide near the quarter mile marker to challenge, gained brief command nearing midstretch but couldn't fend off the winner. PRAIRIE FEVER, urged along to a forward placing from the outset, stalked just outside the pacesetter in the opening half, pressed the pacesetter on the bend into upper stretch, contested the issue inside the top pair past the furlong marker but was outfinished. CROSSWISE, a bit outpaced in early stages racing off the inside, came around some tiring foes to improve her placing in the drive. MAGIC CASE sprinted to the lead along the inside from the break, duelled for command into upper stretch and gave way. WORTHY MISS broke slowly, was then steadied a bit just after the start and never seriously menaced thereafter. QUAKER'S TUNE chased the leaders from the outside racing to the turn, continued three deep between foes leaving the turn, lost her path to the winner in upper stretch and abruptly gave way.
