TERMINAL ONE broke outwards bumping LEGENDARY KING, was quickly righted to stalk just off the pacesetter under rating racing to the backstretch, continued with a steady effort to wrest command leaving the furlong marker and just held LEGENDARY KING under firm handling. The latter, bumped at the start, was reserved off the second flight in the opening half, commenced a steady advance three deep on the far turn, moved to terms with the winner in late stretch and just failed to edge that rival. CROWN OF ARAGORN, held up off the pacesetter along the inside racing to the far turn, couldn't produce the needed closing bid. CHAMPION KID broke inwards bumping LOST FORTY, was righted to track three wide in the second flight racing to the far turn but lacked the needed final response. LIONDRIVE was urged to the lead along the inside, set the pace into upper stretch but emptied out leaving the furlong marker. MELDRICK tracked off the second flight along the inside in the opening half, swung out five wide entering upper stretch but lacked the needed rally. LOST FORTY, bumped, then squeezed between foes at the start, was reserved three deep racing to the backstretch and steadily faded from contention. FOLLOWING THE RACE THE TRAINER OF CROWN OF ARAGORN LODGED A CLAIM OF FOUL AGAINST THE WINNER AT HIS OWNER'S DIRECTION. THE TRAINER OF LEGENDARY KING ALSO LODGED A CLAIM OF FOUL AGAINST THE WINNER, ALLEGING INTERFERENCE AT THE START. THE STEWARDS REVIEWED THE RACE BUT TOOK NO ACTION.
