Gaelic Storm, urged to secure a forward placing outside foes, tracked the leaders racing three wide in second flight to the backstretch, advanced readily in that path entering the far turn to challenge the pacesetter, took over in upper stretch and held sway to the end, drifting out a bit under firm encouragement. Stanley G., shuffled a bit racing to the first turn, tracked the leaders from out of striking distance outside a rival for a half, was switched out three deep on the second bend making steady progress, drifted inwards under pressure racing through the stretch but proved second best. David K, saved ground unhurried in the opening half, steadily gathered momentum while shifting off the inside leaving the far turn, raced four wide into upper stretch,

shifted out near midstretch momentarily impeding READY'S CLYDE but continued willingly to the end to earn a share. LAST DEMAND, bumped by BOOM BOOM CHARLIE at the start, was settled into stride just off the inside, split foes near the inside in upper stretch and was making his best progress late. READY'S CLYDE tracked the leaders unhurried off the inside to the backstretch, made some progress leaving the far turn while being fanned five wide, was forced out by DAVID K near the furlong marker and couldn't menace further. THE ALCOVA KID, reserved near the inside for five furlongs, swung out six wide entering upper stretch but made no impression on the leaders. MACHO CAMACHO was urged to the lead from the break, dueled for command inside a foe into the far turn, dispatched that foe on the far turn but gave way when headed by the winner in upper stretch. SNAPPHOK was settled outside foes in early stages and never mounted a serious challenge. BOOM BOOM CHARLIE broke out, bumped a rival, tracked the pace inside foes as part of the second flight to the far turn, then steadily faded in the drive. GIANT SHIFT never seriously menaced. CRUZATTE was hustled to join the pace outside a rival, forced the issue racing to the far turn and gave way nearing upper stretch. CREEKMORE tracked the pace between foes in second flight to the backstretch but dropped out of contention racing through the far turn. FOLLOWING THE RACE THE RIDER OF READY'S CLYDE LODGED A CLAIM OF FOUL AGAINST THE RIDER OF DAVID K. THE CLAIM WAS DISALLOWED.
