Footnotes

NEVERRRGUWITHRICHIE secured a narrow advantage soon after the break racing nearest the rail, dictated the pace racing into the bend, was roused in upper stretch to maintain her margin and held sway to the end under steady handling. DO THE TIGER, unhurried outside foes in the opening stages, angled in to gain a position between foes in the second flight after the opening furlong, shifted to the rail entering the turn, came through nearing upper stretch to gain striking distance, shifted out racing through the lane but was always only second best. BLACK GIRAFFE, within striking distance four deep in the opening stages, advanced three deep entering the bend to lodge a brief bid nearing upper stretch but weakened in the final quarter while continuing well enough to earn a share. SHAQUITA tracked the leaders inside foes in the second flight, saved ground on the bend, shifted out in upper stretch and split foes five wide late to improve her placing. A BRUSH OF BEAUTY, urged to position in the second flight outside foes, was fanned six wide racing into upper stretch and lacked the needed closing response. APPOINT broke slowly, settled along the inside and never gained contention. PEARL RING was urged to prompt the pace outside the eventual winner racing into the turn but gave way after a half. ABSOLUTELY ALI reared at the start, lacked response despite some pressure in the opening stages and soon trailed.
