Footnotes

CALL TO GLORY was urged to secure the lead along the inside soon after the break, shifted off the rail entering the bend to dictate the pace on a clear margin, held sway into upper stretch and contained the challenge of BLUE CANOE under firm handling. The latter tracked off the second flight while angling to the inside, saved ground on the bend while moving steadily to contention, shifted out in upper stretch to split foes and made steady progress to the end to close the gap. IRON CHAMP settled off the second flight five deep early, advanced four wide racing through the turn to gain contention nearing upper stretch and continued in that path to make mild progress to the end while earning a share. ANTHONY'S PRAYER hopped at the start, was quickly righted to gain a position in the second flight while angling to the inside in the opening half, came through inside foes on the turn to challenge inside the pacesetter but lacked the needed final bid. INDIAN TALK settled three deep between foes from out of striking distance early, briefly awaited an opening racing a bit off the inside on the turn, was shuffled out of tight quarters nearing the quarter mile marker, then switched to the rail in upper stretch to make some belated progress. IKAROS settled six wide in the opening stages, was caught four deep racing through the turn while being urged to contention after six furlongs but lacked the needed final bid. WHERE'S MY SWIPER settled into stride racing five wide between foes and never seriously menaced. TALK IT OUT was outpaced early. PRIDEINYOUREYES worked his way to the rail while settling well out of striking distance, saved ground on the turn while being urged to gain some position but lacked the needed response. JOSIES DISTRACTION joined the pace outside a rival son after the break, couldn't match terms with that foe nearing the bend and gave way after five furlongs. ABACO STORM was a brief factor tracking just off the leaders three deep racing to the bend but was spent after five furlongs.
