Footnotes

BATITO shifted off the inside early tracking the first flight from just out of striking distance racing into the turn, moved to challenge three deep entering upper stretch, gained a narrow advantage in late stages under some right handed pressure and just held the challenge of SWEET LUCA on the wire. The latter broke inwards bumping WEKIVA WACHEE, was settled off the second flight near the inside racing into the bend, made steady progress between foes just off the rail entering the stretch to challenge inside the leaders and just missed. CALMER THAN YOU broke sharply, shifted to the inside dictating the pace on a narrow margin racing into the turn, turned back a challenge in upper stretch to gain a clear advantage, shifted out when being roused to resist the winner's challenge but yielded to the top pair in the final strides. WEKIVA WACHEE bobbed at the start, then threw his head while being bumped, settled into stride along the rail, saved ground to upper stretch, made steady progress nearest the rail racing in tandem with SWEET LUCA in the final quarter but was steadied nearing the wire when losing his path to that foe late. RAZMAN tracked off the first flight a bit off the inside under light rating in the opening stages, shifted out four wide racing into upper stretch and continued with a mild bid. STORMY GOING was rated stalking just off the pacesetter in the opening stages, moved to press the issue on the turn but flattened out nearing midstretch.
