ULTIMATE X., taken in hand just after the start to be reserved out of striking distance along the inside racing into the backstretch, continued under patient handling into the second bend while saving some ground, shifted off the inside nearing upper stretch gathering momentum, angled six wide in upper stretch then produced a solid late response to wrest command in time under firm handling. GREYTAP was prompted to secure a forward placing tracking just off the pacesetter racing into the backstretch, lost some position between calls racing through the far turn, found his best stride nearing the furlong marker to challenge between foes, gained the advantage between calls late but couldn't contain the winner's final bid. GRIZZLED ROBERT was rated just out of striking distance along the inside leading the second flight in the opening half, shifted out three deep on the far turn while moving to challenge for command between foes, continued to dispute the issue in that path past midstretch but was outkicked by the top pair. AMAZING RESULTS, held up between foes tracking off the second flight racing to the far turn, shifted out five deep nearing midstretch and continued with a mild bid while gaining some position. DANDYMAN sped to the lead soon after the break while angling to the inside, dictated the pace on a clear margin racing into the second bend, continued to dispute the issue inside foes past the furlong marker but yielded in the final sixteenth. FIRE CLOUD angled to the rail early tracking the leaders behind the second flight racing into the backstretch, saved ground to upper stretch gaining some position but lacked the needed final kick. PRAIRIE BREEZE tracked off the second flight while shifting outside foes racing to the backstretch, made steady progress racing four wide through the far turn to briefly gain striking distance nearing upper stretch but quickly flattened out in the drive. STAR OF PARADISE, reserved outside a rival in the opening stages, angled to the rail racing into the backstretch while dropping into last and never gained contention. SNAPPED was caught outside foes in the second flight racing to the backstretch, then steadily lost position on the far turn while being fanned seven wide racing into the stretch.
