WILD EXPECTATIONS was allowed to settle, rallied while six wide and made a steady advance to get up in time. HELLO SAILOR was rushed to the lead and set the pace, battled and held place. THE REAL CHAS rated in the second flight inside and saved ground then closed willingly. DEVIL ME NOT showed no speed, had a wide trip and made a mild rally. FULL FLAME pressed the pace between horses, battled to the stretch and faded. MESMERITE rated in the middle of the pack, had a wide trip but made no rally. JAKE'S SOLDIER settled inside, made a bid along the inside but the rider lost his whip at the sixteenth pole. JOHNNIES BREEZE was void of speed, had a rail trip and made no rally. BLYDE RIVER BOY stalked the pace, chased to the stretch and tired. WILLIE TO TO broke through the gate pre-start and was reloaded, then broke sharply but faded quickly.
