RICHYSTHUNDERINGAL joined the pace inside rivals from the outset, was urged to force the issue after the opening quarter, edged forward to a clear advantage on the turn and held sway to the end under steady handling. CHAMPAGNE SPIRIT, held up off the second flight in the opening stages, steadily advanced on the turn splitting foes three deep into upper stretch and continued with interest to prevail for place honors. LITTLE FRANCES worked her way to the rail early tracking off the second flight in the opening half, saved ground on the bend while making steady progress to challenge along the rail entering upper stretch and was just outkicked for second. CHILEAN DREAMS tracked the pace between foes off the second flight in the opening stages, split foes three deep nearing upper stretch to challenge but lacked the needed final kick. CANYON SHADOWS angled to the rail early gaining a position just off the

leaders, shifted out nearing upper stretch while being prompted to challenge the pacesetter briefly but flattened out in upper stretch. SAUDI SERENADE ducked out at the start losing some position, worked her way to the inside racing well off the second flight into the turn but made an effort to improve position inside foes racing into the stretch. TAIBAN MESA tracked the pace outside foes in the second flight, was caught four wide racing through the and steadily retreated entering upper stretch. PASSADE settled between foes in the opening half, was caught five wide nearing upper stretch and lacked a rally. PRINCIPALIA, a bit slow to gather stride, was fanned six wide racing into upper stretch and proved no factor. JULIA'S BREEZE, held up just off the first flight in the opening stages to track the pace between foes, faded from contention early. BOSS GIRL went up to force the pace outside a rival racing into the turn and gave way entering upper stretch. WILD STORY was settled into stride along the inside and soon trailed.
