FULL MANDATE trailed to the stretch, came out five wide for the drive, rallied through the lane and prevailed at the end of a hard drive. BONUS PACK was void of early speed while off the rail, angled out four wide for the drive, rallied to the lead between calls in upper stretch and resisted gamely to the wire. WOODMOON saved ground near the middle of the field, lacked room turning for home, angled out in the stretch and gained belatedly. BAKER ROAD raced four wide near the middle of the field then had no response when called upon. DEFERRED COMP vied for the lead from the inside but tired from his efforts. FIGHT FOR ALLY went up just outside to contest the pace but tired in the drive. SAQUACHE raced close up off the rail but gave way.
