Footnotes

CHUCKS TURN broke readily to gain a narrow advantage between foes dictating the pace in the opening stages, shook clear racing into the bend while shifting inside, steadily widened his advantage under pressure and was taken in hand approaching the wire once the issue was decided. HE GONE broke inwards bumping HOTHALFONE, was righted to track just off the first flight four wide in the opening stages, angled nearer to the inside racing through the bend while being urged to advance on the pacesetter but couldn't match that foe in late stages while turning back a rival to prevail for second. HOTHALFONE, bumped from both sides and shuffled a bit at the start, settled into stride, shifted out four wide nearing the turn while being prompted to advance, raced three wide into upper stretch while failing to gain terms with the winner and was outkicked for the place honors. C F'S RULER was rated tracking just off the leaders along the inside in the opening stages, lost some position when caught in close quarters behind JOSH entering the turn, angled four wide racing into the lane but had no closing response. JOSH, urged along prompting the pacesetter in the opening stages while shifting a bit off the rail, was steadied by his rider racing into the turn and quickly came up empty. CHEVRONS, urged to terms with the eventual winner prompting that foe's pace three deep in the opening stages, angled to the inside midway through the turn and soon gave way.
