SYND was void of early speed, rallied while five wide and was closing well while seven wide in the stretch. LAMPOON raced in the second flight, angled out in the stretch, led late but was outfinished. MILTOS EXPRESS set the pace, drew clear backstretch and gave way late stretch. SARA'S TUNE was shuffled back at the start and closed willingly. VENITIENNE (GB) took back early, moved inside into the stretch and flattened out. MORLANA raced in the middle of the pack, made a five wide in the turn and made a mild late bid. SAMANTHA B. settled between horses and had no response in the stretch. VELVET PEAKS dropped back, moved while five wide in the turn and faded.
