WALL DANCE broke sharply, angled inwards to attend a rival's pace racing to the bend, steadily asserted himself nearing upper stretch to gain a narrow advantage after a half, moved clear in upper stretch and held sway on a widening margin to the end under steady encouragement. HIGH HEIR, forwardly placed near the inside in the opening stages tracking just off the leaders, shifted out three wide entering upper stretch to challenge but couldn't gain terms with the winner while proving best of the others. TEASEBURGER raced unhurried along the inside in the opening quarter while out of striking distance, saved ground on the bend steadily improving position, came around a tiring foe to bid between rivals nearing midstretch, couldn't menace the winner and was outkicked for place honors. MILKY MAY was urged to dispute the pace along the inside racing to the bend, couldn't match the winner after a half and gave way. PARODY, bumped by SMOKEM GREY, then shuffled back at the start, shifted outside foes in the last flight racing to the bend and made an effort to improve his position three wide to late stages. SMOKEM GRAY broke awkwardly bumping a rival, was quickly righted to track the leaders between foes off the inside racing to the bend but lacked the needed final response. TIZ SENSATIONAL tracked the leaders three deep in the second flight in the opening quarter but steadily faded from contention after a half. CHEROKEECHALLENGER settled along the inside early and never mounted a serious challenge.
