Footnotes

WEEKEND PASS, a bit slow into stride, made a steady advance to gain position in the second flight along the inside after the opening half, shifted out three wide to challenge after six furlongs, took over entering upper stretch and held sway to the end under right handed pressure. HUNGRY WILDCAT was rated between rivals off the second flight in the opening half, shifted out on the bend to challenge four wide nearing upper stretch, couldn't gain terms with the winner but proved best of the others. BATTLE POWER settled in last while angling to the inside early, advanced to contention along the rail racing through the turn, shifted out to split foes nearing upper stretch, was shuffled a bit nearing the quarter mile marker, switched out five deep in upper stretch and continued with interest to gain a share. OPTIMER (ARG) settled off the second flight, angled to the inside on the turn, shifted out in upper stretch and made an effort to improve his position three deep between foes to late stages. LORD AND T. tracked the leaders four deep as part of the second flight in the opening half, dropped back from contention on the turn, then split foes just off the inside while making a second effort in late stages to regain some position. TURNPIKE TOMMY moved to dispute the pace inside a rival from the break, dueled for command racing into the turn and gave way entering upper stretch. APACHE CREEK prompted the pace outside a rival in the opening stages, dueled with that foe through the bend and gave way nearing midstretch. MY MAN JAY, forwardly placed three deep stalking just off the first flight in the opening half, steadily retreated nearing upper stretch.
