Footnotes

MAVERICKING, away last, was guided to the inside soon after the break, steadily moved to position off the second flight after the opening half, shifted off the inside on the bend while moving to striking distance four deep between foes, came through tight quarters leaving the quarter mile marker to challenge for command, edged forward leaving the furlong marker and drew clear under energetic handling. FOUR LEFT FEET tracked just off the pacesetter under rating in the opening half, bid for command between foes nearing upper stretch while shifting out three deep leaving the quarter mile marker, couldn't contain the winner's bid but continued with interest to save place honors. LIMESTONE, reserved outside foes in the last flight early, moved to contention with a sharp move on the turn while angling out five wide, pressed the issue outside the eventual winner into upper stretch but flattened out nearing the furlong marker. WILD JAZ, bumped at the start, was quickly righted to secure the lead, dictated the pace on a narrow margin along the inside racing into the bend, couldn't contain the winner's bid and gave way leaving midstretch. DANCE FOR PACO broke inwards bumping WILD JAZ, was settled near the inside for a half, saved ground on the bend while drawing into contention but lacked the needed final response. FIRE CLOUD tracked the pacesetter three deep in second flight in the opening half, made a brief bid in that path on the turn but emptied out early.
