TEST MARKET, never far back, stalked just off the pacesetter unhurried in the opening quarter, steadily drew on terms with that rival after a half, wrested command when prompted in upper stretch, then drew clear under firm handling and some right handed encouragement. PORT HUDSON stalked just off the pacesetter along the inside racing to the bend, shifted a bit off the inside to challenge between foes in upper stretch, couldn't gain terms with the winner but narrowly prevailed for second. GRANITE CITY bobbled at the start, was collected to track the pace unhurried off the second flight, steadily gathered momentum after a half, angled out four wide racing through upper stretch and was just outfinished for place honors. CONECUH tracked the leaders three deep in second flight in the opening stages, lodged a brief bid in that path after a half but failed to sustain his momentum through the final quarter. TRILLIONAIRE settled off the inside from well out of striking distance early and came around some tiring foes racing five deep into the stretch. AMAZING BUD was urged to secure the lead from soon after the break, dictated the pace racing a bit off the inside into the turn, couldn't match the winner once challenged and emptied out in the drive. UNEXPECTEDDIVIDEND, reserved off the second flight while angling inwards in the opening stages, moved to lodge a brief bid between foes nearing upper stretch but quickly proved empty in the drive.
