Footnotes

WORK ALL WEEK broke sharply to secure the advantage while shifting immediately to the inside, dictated the pace on a narrow margin on his own courage racing into the turn, forged clear racing into upper stretch and steadily extended the advantage under pressure. STATIC KILL tracked just off the pacesetter between foes in the opening stages, shifted to the rail on the turn while being urged to advance, couldn't gain terms with the winner but continued with interest to edge a rival for place honors late. HUGHES THE DADDY, urged to gain a forward placing racing just off the pacesetter, prompted that foe racing into the turn, couldn't match that foe racing into upper stretch and lost second nearing the wire. ROCK ON THIS tracked the leaders outside foes off the second flight in the opening stages, made brief progress on the turn to challenge three deep nearing upper stretch but quickly flattened out. BANK ACCOUNT ducked in towards the rail at the start, was righted to track off the second flight near the inside, shifted out entering the turn while briefly gaining contention between foes but steadily faded along the inside in the last quarter. RIVERSHIRE settled in last racing in the turn and passed inside some tiring rivals late. NO RACHMONES tracked the leader inside foes in the second flight racing into the turn, lost some position on the bend, then shifted five wide racing into the stretch but offered no rally. ANY GIVEN TIME was never a factor. SMOKEM GRAY brushed the gate at the start, settled out of striking distance racing to the bend, was fanned six wide entering the stretch but never seriously menaced.
