Footnotes

PLUNDER, carried wide in the opening stages while racing under light reserve from well out of striking distance, gradually moved into contention while shifting out six wide entering upper stretch and produced a steady late response to wrest command in time under firm handling. HE'SARULER, off a step slowly, was hustled up the rail to secure the advantage after the opening quarter, held sway to late stages and just failed to contain the winner. SMARTY BOY tracked the leaders outside foes in the second flight racing to the turn, continued with a steady four wide advance to challenge between foes in that path entering the stretch but was just outkicked. OFFICER DRACO, off a bit slowly, then pinched back at the start, shifted out into the eventual winner's path while tracking off the second flight, made some progress to gain contention racing five wide into upper stretch but was outkicked. J C FIFTY, off slowly, settled off the second flight early, shifted outside foes racing through the turn and made an effort to improve position three deep between foes in the closing stages. CHEVRONS, in touch with the leaders on the pace in the opening stages, tracked the pacesetter near the inside racing into the turn, shifted out to lodge a brief bid nearing upper stretch but quickly faltered in the drive. SIMPLE MAN SKYNYRD, in touch with the first flight three deep between foes in the opening stages, angled to the inside racing through the turn and steadily faded entering upper stretch. NEXTALAST settled outside foes off the second flight early and never gained contention. HOLY CLASSIC was a brief factor between foes in the second flight racing to the turn but retreated early. PERFECT BREEZE was never a factor. PALE HOSE joined the pace five deep in the opening stages, couldn't match the pacesetter racing through the bend and gave way nearing upper stretch.
