SPEEDY WAR was urged five wide in the opening stages to secure terms with a rival on the pace, shifted in after the opening furlong to attend a rival's tempo, edged away to a clear advantage racing into upper stretch and was roused in the closing stages to maintain the lead. ONLY EXCEPTION tracked the pace between foes in the second flight racing into the turn, angled out four wide entering upper stretch and continued with a steady effort to close the gap. IT'S TAMARENO broke slowly, tracked the pace unhurried from well off the second flight racing into the turn, shifted out to split foes four wide in upper stretch and continued willingly between foes in that path to the end to prevail for a share. PICKLE SPRINGS, urged to gain a position inside foes in the second flight racing into the turn, shifted outside a tiring rival in upper stretch to lodge her bid inside the pacesetter but lacked the needed final kick. N'EST CE PAS, held up out of tight quarters at the start, settled between foes racing to the bend, then split foes just off the inside in the closing stages while making an effort to improve position. WAPANUCKA tracked the leaders three deep off the second flight racing into the bend, angled five wide entering upper stretch but offered no rally. CHOCOLATE LATTE settled outside foes in the last flight early, was fanned six wide racing into upper stretch and proved

no real threat. SENORITA CATRINA stumbled at the start, settled near the inside racing to the turn, then shifted out in upper stretch to pass some tiring rivals late. MYKUKUBIRD tracked off the second flight between foes near the inside early, saved ground on the turn to upper stretch but lacked the needed closing response. ORPHANELLE tracked off the second flight along the rail racing into the bend and steadily retreated nearing upper stretch. DAYLIGHT KATY was urged to contention three deep in the second flight in the opening stages but emptied out nearing upper stretch. CHARLOTTS SURPRISE was hustled to the lead along the inside from the break, dueled inside the winner racing into the turn and gave way nearing midstretch when failing to match that foe.
