Footnotes

SUGARED TOAST, reserved racing four wide in the second flight in the opening stages, was eased off the second flight racing into the bend while working her way nearer the inside, steadied in tight quarters after a half, then was urged to split foes just off the inside to challenge inside the pacesetter leaving the furlong marker and prevailed under strong handling. SISTER SISTER sprinted clear of the field while angling over to the inside, turned back a rival to gain a clear advantage racing into upper stretch, but couldn't contain the winner. IZZAEVEN, reserved tracking the leaders from just out of striking distance along the rail early, steadily improved her position inside foes to late stages. VICKY'S BAR, caught in tight quarters in the opening furlong, was allowed to settle, swung out seven wide entering upper stretch and produced her best stride to improve her placing. PEACH BOTTOM tracked the leaders between foes in second flight, shifted out four deep leaving the midway point of the bend while carrying out several rivals, bid between foes for command in upper stretch but flattened out in late stages. DARE RIDGE broke slowly, then was steadied in close quarters, gathered momentum leaving the bend and split foes in late stages to make some mild progress. PRETTY PEACH worked her way to the inside tracking the leaders but couldn't produce the needed closing bid. LONG STORY SHORT, was forced in, then steadied sharply in tight quarters in the opening furlong and never gained striking distance. RICHIEGIRLGOTCLASS was settled off the inside early, shifted out to make a brief, six wide bid racing through the turn but emptied out leaving midstretch. APTITUDE IN ME, forwardly placed along the inside, was forced into the path of LONG STORY SHORT in the opening furlong, recovered to press the pacesetter along the rail leaving the turn and gave way abruptly in upper stretch. CORNER GIRL, forwardly placed outside foes in the opening stages, was carried five wide leaving

the turn and quickly dropped out. O SO PRUDENT angled in sharply after the start while gaining a forward placing impeding APTITUDE IN ME, shifted outside the pacesetter to briefly dispute the issue racing into the bend but emptied out early.
