Footnotes

LALO'S BABY BEAR joined the pace from the outset while angling to the rail, attended a rival's tempo racing into the bend, forged clear when prompted entering upper stretch and held sway to the end under firm right handed encouragement. SEGURO, reserved between foes tracking just off the second flight in early stages, shifted out to split foes four wide after a half challenging the winner, couldn't gain terms with that foe but proved best of the others. CHARLIE BABY, reserved out of close quarters in the opening stages, made steady progress to split foes nearing midstretch and continued willingly to the end for a share. BELELIU tracked the pace between foes in the second flight, was roused to challenge racing three deep entering upper stretch but lacked the needed final response. COLONEL KLINK, reserved just out of striking distance tracking the leaders just off the second flight along the rail, saved ground to upper stretch while briefly gaining striking distance but couldn't produce the needed final response while racing in close quarters through late stages. SORREL OF THE SEA, bumped by HEAVENLY DUE at the start, was quickly righted to gain position stalking just off the leaders in second flight racing to the turn but faded steadily from contention in the last quarter. SPY HUNTER broke in the air, was settled along the inside racing to the turn, angled out six wide splitting foes entering upper stretch and made some belated progress. FROSTED RHYTHM angled inwards to force the pace outside a rival racing to the bend, couldn't match that foe after a half and gave way nearing midstretch. STAR OF PARADISE, pinched back at the start, was fanned seven wide racing into upper stretch but offered no rally. HEAVENLY DUE broke out, bumped a rival, was settled along the inside in early stages but offered no rally. LANDING CHASER broke inwards bumping STAR OF PARADISE at the start, was quickly righted to track the leaders three deep in second flight racing to the bend, drifted out after a half and quickly faded from contention.
