Footnotes

WHAT DO YOU MEAN broke sharply and to a clear advantage, dictated terms to his foes near the inside racing to the bend, was roused to extend his advantage in upper stretch and held sway under firm encouragement to the end. BETTER MAKE MONEY was settled off the inside in early stages, made steady progress racing three deep into upper stretch and continued well enough to secure the place in late stages. DAAREB, bumped by HONEST PROPHET at the start, was righted to track just outside the pacesetter as part of the second flight racing to upper stretch but offered no final response. HONEST PROPHET broke out, bumped DAREEB, was guided to the rail tracking just off the pacesetter nearing the bend, shifted out a bit after a half to briefly challenge between foes but quickly proved empty and steadily weakened in the final stages. GOALTOGOAL tracked the leaders unhurried along the rail, was shuffled a bit when losing his path to a rival nearing the bend but dropped out after a half.
