WILDWOOD ARAGORN was urged to secure the lead while angling to the rail entering the first turn, relinquished the lead to a rival midway through the backstretch, responded to force the issue inside foes nearing upper stretch, shifted out bumping BERNARDUS repeatedly racing through the stretch but edged away late under firm right handed encouragement. DR. JAJÓ tracked the pace unhurried outside foes racing off the second flight racing to the far turn, swung out four wide nearing upper stretch and continued in that path to secure place honors late. WHERE'S THE BABY angled to the rail in the opening furlong to gain a position in the second flight, shifted out nearing the far turn, raced in tight quarters between foes leaving the midway point of the far turn, switched back to the rail in upper stretch and produced a solid late response to gain a share. BERNARDUS, urged to a forward placing along the inside, stalked the leaders along the rail into the backstretch, shifted out after a half while momentarily impeding several foes, moved to challenge between foes just outside the winner nearing upper stretch, was bumped repeatedly in the final stages and lost his momentum. HARRISON COUNTY tracked the pace outside foes in the second flight advance to challenge four wide leaving the far turn but flattened out in upper stretch. TURN N' FIRE, allowed to settle well off the pace in the opening half, was fanned seven wide racing into upper stretch and passed some tiring rivals. LONGER VERSION, restless in the gate before the start, tracked the pace unhurried along the inside from out of striking distance, made some progress to gain position racing into the far turn, was steadied off IDEAL ALLUVIAL approaching the quarter mile marker and proved empty in the drive. IDEAL ALLUVIAL was urged to secure a forward

placing three deep racing into the first turn, angled inwards to press the pacesetter before a half, contested the issue between foes racing into the second bend and emptied out midway through the far turn. VOLUNTEER KITTEN tracked the pace between foes off the second flight in the opening stage, was shuffled a bit in traffic after a half, continued three deep into the second bend and offered no rally. HIPPODROME settled near the inside early, steadied off a rival nearing the far turn, was steadied in traffic nearing the quarter mile marker and never seriously menaced.
