**Footnotes**

BELAFONTE, forwardly placed three deep stalking just off the first flight, made a steady advance to challenge in that path nearing upper stretch, then edged forward to gain a clear advantage leaving the sixteenth marker under firm handling. WELL RESPECTED MAN worked his way to the inside tracking the leaders in the second flight, shifted out three deep in upper stretch and continued with interest to late stages to close the gap. KNIGHT SHOT attended a rival's pace under some reserve in the opening stages, pressed the issue between foes racing into upper stretch, resisted the winner's challenge but proved no match late. SEVEN MILE BRIDGE was urged to the lead along the inside from the break, dueled for command into upper stretch but weakened when failing to match the winner late. SPANISH BARON settled along the inside off the second flight, shifted out to split foes racing into upper stretch but had no final kick. ZIZI CAT, reserved between foes in the last flight early, advanced entering the turn to make a brief bid three deep between foes after a half but lacked the needed final kick. GENTLE MOMENT, caught five deep in the opening stages, continued four deep racing into the turn and steadily faded nearing upper stretch. MILITARY LEGEND settled into stride along the inside, saved ground to upper stretch but never gained contention. CITIZEN WEST tracked the pace four deep off the second flight but dropped out of contention early.
