SUNSHINE EXPRESS, forwardly placed along the inside, was eased off the pacesetter to lead the second flight tracking that foe from just out of striking position, shifted out on the bend while moving in tandem with a rival to challenge for command, struck the front in upper stretch and edged away late under firm right handed encouragement. NAGYS PIGGY BANK angled inwards to gain position tracking the pacesetter in the second flight, moved in tandem with the eventual winner to challenge three deep after a half but proved no match for his rival late while clearly best of the others. COUGAR'S SHADOW tracked off the second flight outside foes in the opening stages, split foes three deep racing into upper stretch and made an effort to improve position. ANY GIVEN TIME tracked off the second flight along the inside in early stages, shifted out on the bend to bid between foes but lacked the needed final kick. C. C. BANJO settled in hand early, shifted inwards exchanging some contact with HEY NEIGHBOR in the opening furlong, split rivals racing into upper stretch and displayed some belated interest between foes. GRUDGE MATCH sped clear of the field while angling over in the opening quarter, set the pace on a commanding margin racing into the turn but gave way once headed by the winner. LAKE POSSE hopped at the start, was quickly righted to chase the leaders four deep racing into the turn but steadily faded after a half. PANAMA HAT settled along the inside early and never gained contention. IN ALL

DIRECTIONS was urged to contention while shifting nearer the inside racing in second flight in the opening quarter, angled to the rail on the turn but was spent after a half. OFFICER NINO tracked the pace between foes off the second flight racing to the bend but steadily faded nearing upper stretch. WILD COMMAND, caught four deep in the last flight early, never seriously menaced. HEY NEIGHBOR was settled between foes, exchanged contact with C. C. BANJO in the opening furlong and soon dropped out.
