Footnotes

HELLO SAILOR was guided to the rail in the opening stages while racing unhurried from just out of striking distance, made a steady advance inside foes on the bend drawing into contention, shifted out three deep nearing midstretch and produced a solid late response to just edge WEBSTER in time under firm left handed encouragement. The latter, forwardly placed along the inside from the outset, advanced on the pacesetter to press the issue racing into the turn, moved clear in upper stretch but couldn't quite fend off the winner's late bid. CITY NUMBER, a bit slow into stride, shifted off the inside racing through the turn, swung out five wide in upper stretch and continued with interest to edge a rival for a share. GALLOPING GULCH broke outwards bumping TWYLAS RED CAT, tracked the pacesetter three deep between foes, was herded inwards approaching the turn, continued along the inside into upper stretch to make some progress along the rail but was outfinished for a share. FOXIE'S BOY sped to the lead a bit off the inside in the opening furlong, disputed the pace outside a rival racing into the bend and gave way leaving midstretch. AWESOME BREW tracked off the second flight between foes in the opening stages, shifted four wide in upper stretch but lacked the needed closing response. TWYLAS RED CAT, bumped at start, was quickly righted to track the pacesetter four wide in the second flight, shifted inwards nearing the bend while momentarily impeding GALLOPING GULCH and soon faded from contention.
