COSTILLA RANGE secured a tracking position outside foes in the second flight while under some reserve in the opening stages, angled inwards to race between foes after the opening half, continued in hand while awaiting an opening nearing the quarter mile marker, shifted three deep in upper stretch, then surged to wrest command from NUCKSER when presented an opening in the closing stages to prevail under steady handling. The latter moved to the fore inside foes in the opening quarter, dictated the pace a bit off the inside racing into the bend, went clear entering upper stretch but proved only second best when confronted by the winner. MAGIC MAN settled off the inside from well off the second flight early, shifted out four wide nearing upper stretch while moving to contention and continued willingly five deep in the stretch to gain a share. GAVILAN tracked the pace inside foes as part of the second flight under light rating, steadily drew into contention midway through the bend, awaited an opening nearing upper stretch, shifted off the inside while being roused to challenge racing through the stretch but was outkicked. FLAG INDY settled well off the leaders in the opening half, saved some ground on the bend and passed inside some tiring rivals late. SHOEFLY SHOEFLY settled off the second flight while angling to the inside, made some progress in that path on the turn, shifted out five wide entering upper stretch and had no further response. WEDGEWOOD, prominent between foes in the opening furlong, was eased off the first flight to track those foes under light rating, moved to challenge three deep between foes nearing the bend, continued in that path under pressure racing through the bend and emptied out nearing upper stretch. CANTONIC, forwardly placed outside foes in the opening stages stalking the pace, was caught four wide racing into the turn and soon faded from contention. LARKFLITE, forwardly placed between foes in the opening stages,

pressed the pace outside the leader racing into the turn and gave way after six furlongs.
