### Footnotes

BASILIO'S THUNDER was guided to the inside in the opening stages racing unhurried while just out of striking distance in the second flight, commenced a steady advance inside foes on the far turn, shifted outside the pacesetter while wresting command with a sharp move in upper stretch and held sway to the end under steady encouragement. THE BEST OPTION, reserved from well out of striking distance off the inside in the opening half, swung out four wide entering the far turn while making steady progress, couldn't menace the winner but prevailed for place honors on the wire. DANCING DEMONETTE, caught four wide in the opening stages, tracked the leaders three deep in the second flight to the far turn, bid three deep between foes racing into upper stretch and was outfinished for second. SUSPENDED MOON settled along the inside off the second flight early, made some brief progress inside foes on the far turn but lost her momentum when her rider lost his whip near the furlong marker. ROYAL ALLUVIAL pulled her way to the lead along the inside racing to the backstretch, forged clear entering the far turn but emptied out in upper stretch once headed by the winner. HURRACANE KATIE, held up tracking off the first flight between foes racing to the far turn, retreated from contention early. PRIMA DONNA PIRATE was firmly rated stalking just off the pacesetter in the opening half, couldn't match that foe and quickly emptied out racing through the far turn. GLORIOUS DESTINY, forwardly placed three deep tracking the pacesetter, soon dropped out nearing the far turn.
