Footnotes

DAD ARE WE HERE gained a position in the second flight between foes tracking the leaders unhurried in the opening half, shifted out three deep nearing upper stretch while moving to terms with the leaders, took over nearing the sixteenth marker and drew away late under firm left handed encouragement. BE BRAVE, held up off the second flight near the inside racing to the bend, shifted out midway through the turn to split foes three wide, shifted out four wide racing through the stretch and narrowly prevailed for second. YOU DANCING DEMON tracked the pace unhurried outside a rival off the second flight in the opening half, shifted out four wide leaving the turn advancing to contention, continued with interest five deep to late stages and was just outfinished for second. LETHAL broke inwards, raced off the second flight along the inside, saved ground on the bend moving to contention after six furlongs, shifted off the inside nearing midstretch and continued willingly between foes while just outfinished for a share. MY FEVER was urged to secure a forward placing three deep in the opening stages, moved to press the issue outside the pacesetter racing into upper stretch, struck the front near the furlong marker but yielded to the leaders late. COCKY BULL broke inwards bumping GOLD DOUBLE, was quickly righted, then urged to the lead along the inside, set the pace into upper stretch and faltered in late stages. BOXEO, forced inwards at the start, settled into stride outside foes, raced five deep entering the turn and offered no closing bid. CAPTAIN AMERICAN settled between foes off the second flight in the opening stages and continued evenly into the stretch. KIDS GAME settled three deep in early stages, made brief progress five wide on the turn but flattened out in upper stretch. CHIEF CHICAGO broke slowly, settled along the inside and never menaced thereafter. GOLD DOUBLE, bumped, then forced into the path of BOXEO at the start, recovered to briefly contend three deep in the second flight, steadied in close quarters midway through the turn and quickly emptied out. POTENTATE, a bit rank while pulling his rider to a forward placing along the inside in the opening stages, was spent after five furlongs.
