JUMPIN JORDYN settled near the inside well off the second flight in the opening half, split foes commencing her advance racing through the turn, shifted out three deep entering upper stretch and continued with a steady response to prevail in time under firm left handed encouragement. LOST ACCOUNT broke readily, tracked the pacesetter outside a rival three deep in the opening quarter, moved to wrest command leaving the five furlong marker, dictated the pace along the inside on a clear margin to upper stretch but failed to contain the winner's bid. SOUP IS UP was urged to the fore from the outset while shifting off the inside, relinquished the lead to a rival after three furlongs, tracked that rival along the inside to upper stretch but lacked the needed final response. AFRICA ON MY MIND settled well out of striking distance off the inside in the opening stages, saved some ground racing through the turn while gaining some position, shifted out in upper stretch and continued to make mild progress to late stages. POCANELLA tracked off the second flight near the inside in the opening half and steadily faded from contention on the turn. LAYNEE BUG was rated off the second flight outside a rival in the opening half, advanced to make a brief bid three deep entering the bend but flattened out after six furlongs. PLAY HARD, forwardly placed tracking just off the leaders along the inside in the opening stages, retreated from contention early.
