Footnotes

SANTINA DOND secured a narrow lead along the inside in the opening stages, dictated the pace racing into the bend, edged clear into upper stretch, drifted out under left handed pressure leaving the furlong marker, but was righted in the closing stages to fend off a bid from SEEKING SHEBA under firm right handed encouragement. The latter settled well off the leaders while angling inwards a bit, shifted outside foes to make steady progress three deep racing through the turn, was brushed entering upper stretch by JITTERBUG BLUES while being forced into the four path, shifted in under right handed pressure while moving to striking distance nearing the furlong marker crossing the path of JITTERBUG BLUES, then altered course avoiding the winner in the final furlong and proved only second best. JITTERBUG BLUES tracked the pace unhurried just off the second flight between foes, steadily drew into contention near the inside on the bend, shifted off sharply leaving the turn brushing SEEKING SHEBA, then was steadied off that foe racing through upper stretch when losing her path, switched out four wide in late stages and continued under pressure to gain a share. MY SUGAR BEAR tracked the pace unhurried off the second flight along the inside in the opening stages, shifted off the inside racing through the bend, angled five wide racing through the stretch and continued to make mild progress. JONMIL'S EDGE tracked just off the pacesetter under rating well off the inside in the opening stages, angled inwards nearing the turn to press the issue, couldn't match the winner after six furlongs and faded along the inside late. PRAIRIE ACADEMY, held up just off the second flight four deep in the opening stages, made a brief bid outside foes racing into the turn but retreated from contention early. KATHLEEN L tracked just off the pacesetter three deep in the second flight under rating in early stages but was through after a half. FOLLOWING THE RACE THE RIDER OF SEEKING SHEBA LODGED A CLAIM OF FOUL AGAINST THE WINNER. THE TRAINER AND JOCKEY OF JITTERBUG BLUES ALSO LODGED A CLAIM OF FOUL AGAINST SEEKING SHEBA WITH ALL PARTIES ALLEGING INTERFERENCE. THE STEWARDS CONDUCTED AN INQUIRY INTO THE STRETCH RUN BUT ELECTED TO TAKE NO ACTION.
