Footnotes

DOILOOKFATNTHESE broke readily to secure a clear advantage just off the inside racing into the first turn, dictated the pace on a comfortable margin to the second bend, was roused to maintain her advantage racing into upper stretch and drew away late under steady pressure. BILL'S PRESENCE made her way to the rail in the opening furlong while gaining position just off the pacesetter, stalked that foe in tandem with several foes into the far turn, shifted off nearing upper stretch to challenge the winner but proved no match. AMERICA'S BLOSSOM settled saving ground in the opening half, switched off the inside entering the far turn, swung five wide racing into upper stretch and made some belated progress to gain a share. HERE OUI GO AGAIN settled off the second flight outside foes in the opening stages, advanced four wide leaving the far turn commencing her advance, made some progress midway through the second bend but came up empty nearing upper stretch. JAZZ ODYSSEY angled inwards to track the pace between foes behind the second flight, shifted to the rail entering the far turn while making some brief progress nearing upper stretch but lost her momentum entering the lane. READYBDANCING stalked the pacesetter outside a rival racing to the backstretch, continued between foes racing into the far turn but steadily retreated after six furlongs. ALL HER DUE broke slowly, settled off the inside and never gained contention. FIRST OF FEBRUARY tracked just off the second flight three deep between foes, continued in that path to make a brief bid entering the far turn but quickly came up empty nearing upper stretch. BERRY KNOLL, reserved off the second flight along the inside in the opening quarter, steadied a bit while racing a bit rank entering the backstretch and steadily faded from

contention. GREEN DIAMOND LADY tracked the pace outside foes into the first turn, bolted nearing the three quarter mile marker and trailed thereafter.
