Footnotes

DEVILS TOWER broke slowly, settled last near the inside racing into the bend, gathered momentum midway through the turn while shifting off the inside, split foes leaving the quarter mile marker while angling out three deep, shifted inwards under pressure crossing the path of SALTY RULER leaving midstretch but continued with a solid late response to wrest command and go clear in time under firm encouragement. SILKEN BO sped clear of his foes along the rail, held sway on a clear margin past midstretch but couldn't contain the winner's final bid. SALTY RULER worked his way to the inside tracking the pacesetter as part of the second, shifted off the rail entering upper stretch while being prompted to advance on the pacesetter, steadied out of close quarters when momentarily losing his path to the eventual winner and couldn't match terms with the top pair late. STRAPPING raced well wide in the opening quarter, continued while being prompted to advance four deep on the turn to upper stretch, then continued evenly in that path to late stages. CADCAM, urged along pursuing the pacesetter racing into the turn, couldn't gain terms with that foe and gave way nearing midstretch. HEART DOCTOR tracked off the second flight outside foes racing into the turn and dropped out after a half.
